

## DARC Skywarn Net Standby Mode Script

This is **your call sign** for the DARC SKYWARN. The National Weather Service has issued (indicate type of Hazardous Weather Watch). At present, there is (*announce all watches and warnings affecting the repeater coverage area*).

The DARC SKYWARN Net is in the stand-by mode at this time and the repeater is open for normal amateur use. We ask that you keep your transmissions short and please wait for the reset tone to allow for breaking stations.

The SKYWARN Net does not take routine check-ins in a standby-by status; however, any stations that have severe weather reports should call net control at this time or break in at any time. **PAUSE**

The National Weather Service is looking for reports of tornadoes on the ground, funnel clouds aloft, wall clouds, hail of any size, damaging winds, flooding (other than normal run-off problems) and any other storm damage. Any report not meeting these criteria, should not be passed unless specifically requested by Net Control.

This is **your call sign**, SKYWARN Net Control, standing by.

*Please indicate that there is a standby weather net in progress every 10-15 minutes until the standby net is upgraded to a full net or the standby net is closed.*
